1. PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

- 1) Players are only eligible to compete in this tournament if they are a member of a team that is Representative of an Indoor Sports Club or Stadium that is a current financial member of either Northern Indoor Sports Incorporated, Central Indoor Sports Incorporated or Southern Indoor Sports Incorporated.
- 2) Players will only be deemed to be a member of a team that is representative of an Indoor Sports Club or Stadium if that Club or Stadium is located within the Region in which such player permanently resides.
- 3) If a player has never represented any Indoor Sports Club or Stadium at any NZIS sanctioned event or competition they may represent any Club or Stadium competing in this event, but only in so far as they do so in accordance with Rule.1(2) above.
- 4) If a player has represented an Indoor Sports Club or Stadium in any 2010 Regional Superleague match held prior to the start of this Tournament, they must represent that same Club or Stadium during this tournament.
- 5) If a player has not represented an Indoor Sports Club or Stadium in any 2010 Regional Superleague match held prior to the start of this tournament, but they have previously played at a Representative level during the period from 01 May 2003 to 30 April 2010, such player is only permitted to represent the Club or Stadium that they most recently represented during this specified period.
- 6) The only exceptions to Rule.1 (4) and Rule.1 (5) above are as follows;
 - a) **Inter-Club/Stadium Transfer** – An Inter-Club/Stadium transfer has been approved in writing by either Northern Indoor Sports Incorporated, Central Indoor Sports Incorporated or Southern Indoor Sports Incorporated prior to the **30th of July 2010**.
 - b) **Inter-Regional Transfer** –An Inter-Regional Transfer has been approved in accordance with Rule.1 (7) detailed below.
- 7) For the purpose of Rule.1 (6) (b) above, to successfully obtain an Inter-Regional Transfer the following criteria must be met;
 - a) The player must be able to prove their change of permanent residency.
 - b) The Indoor Sports Club or Stadium that such player last represented must approve the transfer.
 - c) Both Regional Sports Bodies affected by such transfer must approve the transfer.
 - d) All transfer approvals must be made in writing.
- 8) Any player who has successfully obtained an Inter-Regional Transfer must first represent their new Indoor Sports Club or Stadium at a Regional Superleague level before competing in this event.
- 9) All players who have successfully obtained either of the transfer types detailed in Rule.1 (6) above must be able to provide written confirmation of such transfers if requested to do so by a Tournament Official. Failure to be able to produce transfer confirmation will result in the offending player being removed from the tournament and any game(s) in which they have participated in will be awarded as a default win to the opposing team(s).
- 10) Players may only play for one team during the course of this tournament.

2. AGE RESTRICTED GRADES

- 1) All Players competing in the 19 and Under Colts Grade must be 19 years of age or younger as at the 5th of September 2010.
- 2) All Players competing in the Over 30/35 Masters Grade must be 30 years of age or older as at the 3rd of September 2010.
- 3) All Players competing in an age restricted grade must be able to produce either an original birth certificate, photo driver's license or passport to verify their age if requested to do so by a Tournament Official.
- 4) Failure to be able to produce satisfactory age verification will result in the offending player being removed from the tournament and any game(s) in which they have participated in will be awarded as a default win to the opposing team(s).

3. OPEN MENS GRADE

- 1) Clubs or Stadiums may only enter teams into this grade if such teams are comprised entirely of players that have not played at a premier level in any Regional Superleague match played during the 2010 representative season.
- 2) If a Club or Stadium has entered a team into the Premier Men's Grade for this event they may also field premier level players in a team that they have entered in the Open Men's Grade.
- 3) In all other cases, any current premier level player who wishes to play in this grade may only do so if they have applied to New Zealand Indoor Sports Incorporated for dispensation to participate and have had this application approved in writing prior to the 2nd of August 2010.
- 4) Any player who has successfully gaining such dispensation must be able to provide written confirmation of their dispensation if requested to do so by a Tournament Official. Failure to be able to produce dispensation confirmation will result in the offending player being removed from the tournament and any game (s) in which they have participated will be awarded as a default win to the opposing team(s).

4. PLAYER REGISTRATION

- 1) Each team is permitted to use and register a total of twelve (12) players during the course of the tournament, and each team must register their players on the Official Team Registration Cards prior to the start of their first tournament game.
- 2) The names originally registered cannot be altered or extended in any form and only those players registered prior to the commencement of their team's first game will be eligible to play in the tournament.
- 3) Each team may use a maximum of eight players per match, and these players must be registered on the Official Match Registration/Score Sheets prior to the toss for each game being taken.

5. MATCH RULES

- 1) All games will be played in accordance with the Official Rules of New Zealand Indoor Cricket as determined and may be amended from time to time by New Zealand Indoor Sports Incorporated.

6. UMPIRES

- 1) Each match shall be adjudicated by one Umpire and the appointment of Umpires shall be at the sole discretion of the Tournament Officials.
- 2) All Clubs or Stadiums entering teams must provide a minimum number of suitably qualified umpires to adjudicate during this event, and the minimum number of Umpires that each Club or Stadium must provide is as follows:
 - a) 1 or 2 Teams Entered A minimum of one Umpire must be provided
 - b) 3 or 4 Teams Entered A minimum of two Umpires must be provided
 - c) 5 or More Teams Entered A minimum of three Umpires must be provided
- 3) All Clubs and Stadiums that do not provide either the minimum number or Umpires required by their team entries, or fail to provide the Umpires as per the roster supplied with the Tournament Programme, may have teams removed from the event to ensure that the correct Umpire to Team ratio is achieved.
- 4) The grades from which any such teams are to be removed from shall be at the absolute discretion of the Event Manager and any such teams removed for this reason will not be eligible for a refund of their team entry fee.
- 5) All Clubs or Stadiums must list the names of their Umpires attending on the Official Team Entry Form at the time of entering their team(s) for this event.

7. PRIZES AND AWARDS

- 1) All awards will be presented during the Tournament, details of which will be made available in the tournament packs sent to all teams entered.
