- 2/. Develop players knowledge of what is expected.
- 3/. Ensure the team upholds the highest level of conduct at all times.
- 4/. Managing the "on-field" activities of the team.
- 5/. Ensure all players are at maximum fitness.
- 6/. Develop a game plan and communicate effectively the plan to the team.
- 7/. Liaison with the team's manager on all plans and activities
- 8/. Co-ordinate team activities in association with the team manager:
  - Practise sessions
  - Meeting times
  - Playing and Formal Uniforms to be at their highest standard at all times
  - Training uniforms to be worn at all official training sessions
- 9/. Representing New Zealand Indoor Cricket all Official Functions.
- 10/. Reporting requirements following the tournament, as outlined by National Office

The team manager is ultimately responsible for the control of the team off the field of play as well as ensuring that the tasks set for the players are completed.

The appointee will be expected to provide a strong leadership role to ensure that the players are aware of what is required and to the satisfaction of the team coach and New Zealand Indoor Cricket.

On a personal level the manager will be required to undertake a pastoral care role to provide support and empathy for what may be a wide-range of individual concerns.

**General Responsibilities include:**

- 1/. Managing the "off-field" activities of the team.
- 2/. Develop players' knowledge and adherence of expectations and protocols.
- 3/. Ensure the team upholds the highest level of conduct at all times.
- 4/. Representing New Zealand Indoor Cricket at all Official Functions.
- 5/. Liaison with the team's coach on all plans and activities.
- 6/. Enforce "team rules".
- 7/. Co-ordinate team activities in association with the team coach:
  - Practise sessions
  - Meeting times
  - Playing and Formal Uniforms to be at their highest standard at all times
  - Training uniforms to be worn at all official training sessions
  - Ensure all team members are aware of transfers, check-in procedures and any other travel arrangements including equipment and personal luggage.

**Mission Statement:** Promoting excellence in New Zealand Indoor Cricket

**Objective**

The primary objective of any national representative team is to ensure that as a whole and without limitation, the team perform to their maximum level in representing their controlling body and ultimately their country.

The Sports Trainer should co-operatively, with team coaches and managers, see that every team member is motivated and be of physical fitness to perform at 100% effort at all times.

**Responsibilities**

The sports trainer has the responsibility for the teams playing condition on the field in ensuring that correct treatment is provided when required.

The sports trainer is ultimately responsible for the treatment of the team off the field of play as well as ensuring that the coaches and managers are educated to any injuries of players that may cause a reduction in that players ability to perform at their maximum level. At the same time he/she should provide injury progress reports to the management team whilst ensuring the injured party is educated to what is needed to expedite his/her recovery period.

The appointee will be expected to provide a strong leadership role to ensure that the players, managers and coaches are aware of what is required and to the satisfaction of New Zealand Indoor Cricket.

**General Responsibilities include:**

- 1/. Managing the "off- field" and "on-field" injuries of the teams.
- 2/. Develop players' knowledge and adherence to recovery protocol.
- 3/. Liaison with the team managers and coaches on all players where necessary.
- 4/. Maintain appropriate levels of supplies for both Medical Kits
- 5/. Enforce his/her rulings on injury prevention and rehabilitation.
- 6/. Representing New Zealand Indoor Cricket at all Official Functions.
- 7/. Co-ordinate team activities in association with the team coach:
  - Warm-up protocols
  - Practise sessions
  - "Pre-match" individual medical player requirements are fulfilled.
  - Dietary and hydration requirements are administered and enforced.
- 8/. Reporting requirements following the tournament, as outlined by National Office
